

6 a) After loading weaners do step #3 in reverse without touching the ground. Take the mat and place it off to the side or under bunk of truck so it is not reused. When you reach destination use the 2nd floor mat in tote and start at #1.

b) After loading market hogs place coveralls, boots, gloves and floor mats back in Tote.

*Note: Used gloves and coveralls **ARE NOT** to be worn in the cab of the truck*



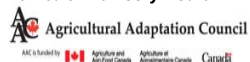
NOTE:

- Farm personnel bring the pigs to the end of the chute and the driver handles the pigs from there.
- One-way flow of pigs over the clean/dirty line must be ensured.
- Farm personnel may never enter the truck and the driver may never enter the chute or barn.

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Preparation:

If customer requires use of totes ensure you have enough clean totes to complete the shipment. Load shavings and or straw into vehicle if required.

NOTE: All bedding materials must be from the Clean Bedding storage.

Loading and Unloading

1. Open Clean Tote and remove floor mat. Place floor mat on ground to act as the clean area, close enough to truck to allow easy entry.



2. Remove pullover boots from Clean Tote. Place upright on floor mat



3. Put on coveralls, not allowing coveralls to touch the ground and stepping into pullover boots on the mat. Do not touch the clean area without rubber boots and do not allow clean rubber boots to touch ground.



4. Put on gloves from the Clean Tote



5. Use the rim or ladder to step up into the trailer. Do not touch the ground/tire.
